



**Legend Lodge** on Lake Iliamna in Alaska has offered our TU Chapter members some discounted trips for this year (2009). Alaska's Legend Lodge is located 250 miles Southwest of Anchorage on the Alaskan Peninsula in the world famous Bristol Bay Fishery.

### **July 6-July 15**

Combination of Trout/Char on the Copper River for one part of the trip with the second part being either King Salmon on the Nusagak River or Silver/Sockeye/Char/Trout on other Iliamna drainages. Fly outs are on a Beaver float plane.

The Legend Lodge hosts 6 people, each in their own bedroom, with a chef on site. The King Salmon venue is a tent camp. Each person has a new 10X12 tent on a platform, cots and sleeping bags, hot showers, and outhouses. King Salmon fishing is predominantly spin & bait casting, but some fly fishing opportunities exist. Everything else is fly fishing.

Cost is \$1500/person and we must book 4 people to do the trip.

### **July 17-24**

Same offer as above except there is only room for 2 people at \$1500/person. This is prime dry fly fishing season for Trout/Char.

### **August 28-Sep 4**

Strictly Trout/Char on Iliamna drainages staying at Legend Lodge. This is the prime time for Rainbows; lots of egg patterns.

### **Transportation**

Individuals are responsible for flights to Anchorage and then on to Iliamna. Generally, an overnight in Anchorage is required so that you can catch the first flight to Iliamna. Fare from Anchorage to Iliamna is roughly \$250 one-way. If the trip includes King Salmon Lodge, then the return flight will be from Dillingham to Anchorage. That fare is roughly \$300 one-way. No overnight in Anchorage is generally required on this leg.
